The success of our Faith Formation programs each year reflects the spirit of community service here at Our Lady Mother of the Church parish. We are grateful for any service you can give. We will need parents/families to help in the following area:

Church Picnic: We will have our annual parish family picnic on Sunday, June 1st, 2025. We need help with the set-up, clean-up, serving, and entertainment.

Sunday Coffee and Donuts: We need families to volunteer on Sundays from September through June to set-up 'Sunday Coffee and Donuts' before the 10:30 am Mass and clean-up after. Donuts are donated by Shoprite and can be picked up on Sunday morning in Hillsdale. Sign-up link will be emailed to you.

Catechist: After an orientation / training session, you will be assigned a class of up to 15 students. At each session, you will guide your group through one or two activities. You will receive activity plans and outlines for each session and preparation time is about 30 minutes for each lesson. Catechist aids help the catechist and prevent a situation where the catechist is alone with the students. These are our most important positions, and we will not be able to have a program at all if we do not get enough catechists.

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN: In keeping with the Archdiocese of Newark mandate, all Our Lady Mother of the Church's Religious Education catechists and aides MUST participate in Protecting God's Children. This program trains them to be proactive in discerning child abuse. This awareness, coupled with the screening of all volunteers who have access to children, helps our parish create a safer environment for the children. The workshop is facilitated by a certified instructor and given free of charge to all new volunteers and any interested parents.

We also adhere to the New Jersey State Statutes that require the NJ Division of Child Protection and Permanency (formerly DYFS) be notified immediately if an R.E. staff member suspects that a child has been abused.
